## **Interpretation**



The university had made many changes in the curriculum and syllabi of courses in every year, and from the analysis it is clear that the teachers all have favorable attitude towards these changes. The factors which are to be noted that the curriculum flexible (64.00%), Number of hours (64.00%), sufficient skill (64.00%) and the functional extension of daily life (60.00%) and Over rating of curriculum (75.00%). 






Table 07: Availability of syllabus based on e-resources




Table 08: Proportionality of the syllabus to the number of hours available




Table 09: Standard of the text books- Internationally/Nationally accepted




Table 10: Introduction of new and add on courses.




Table 11: Functional extension of the syllabus in daily life



