2017 January 17

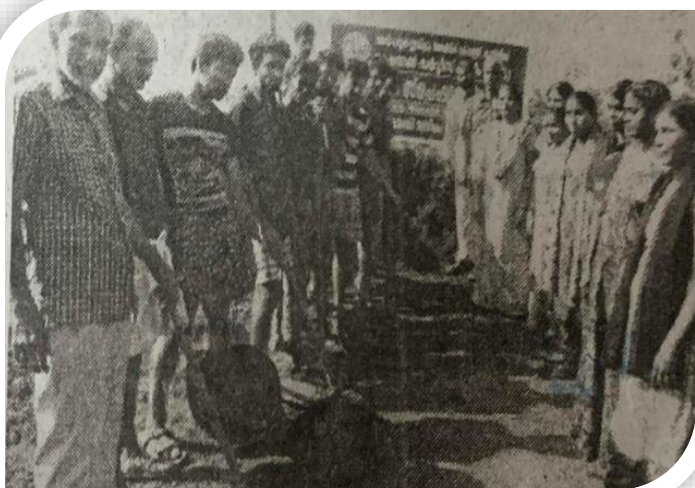

HONOURING FARMERS



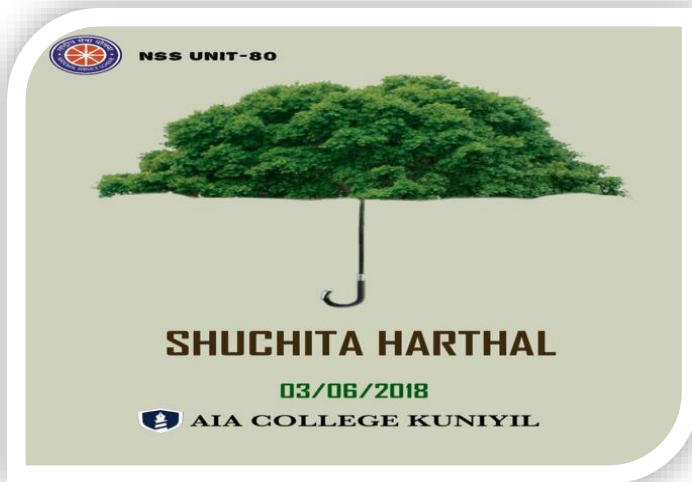

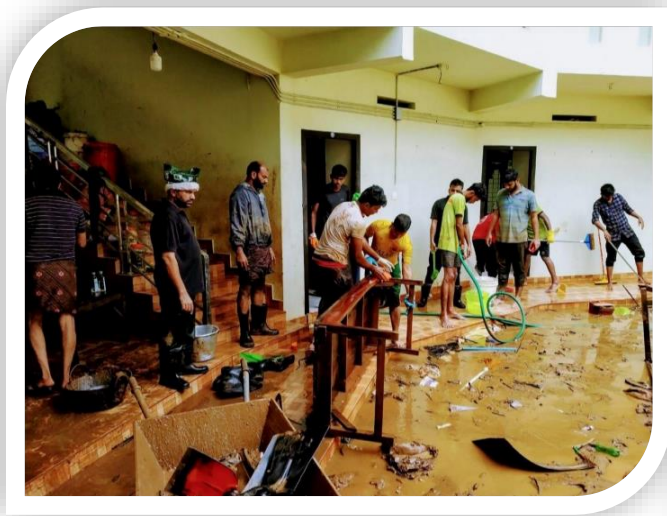

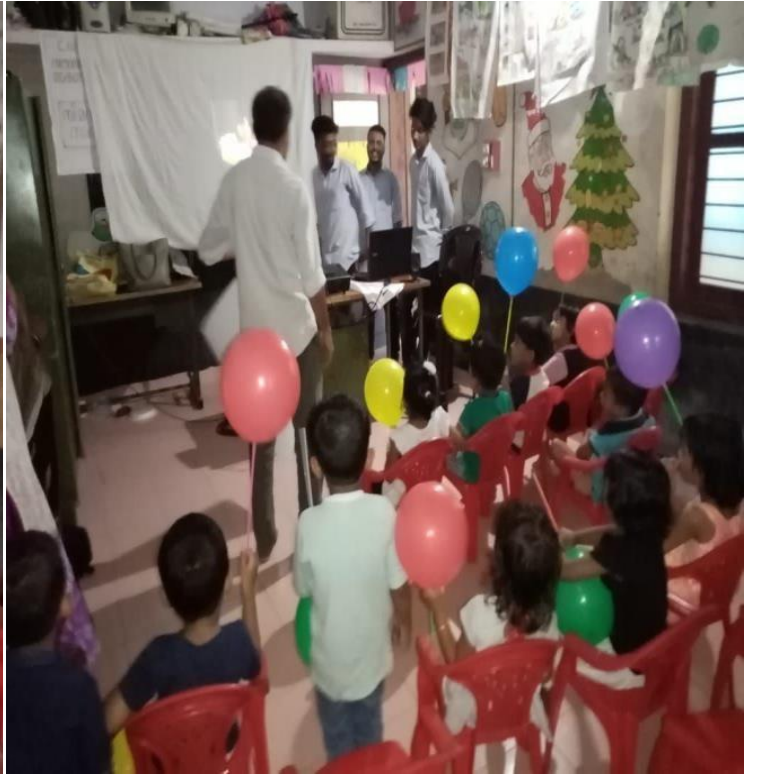
CHILDREN'S DAY

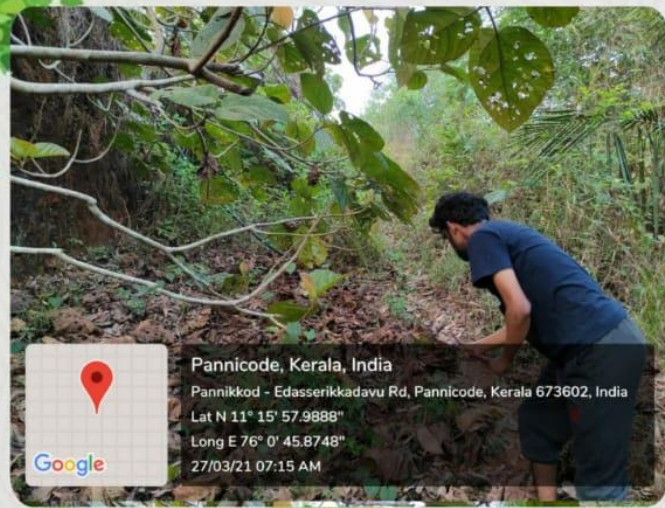

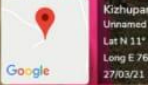

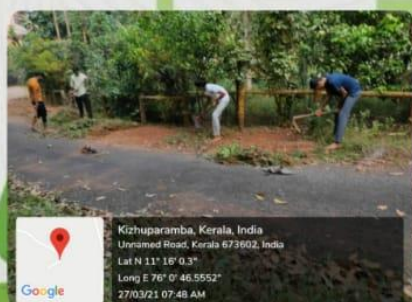
