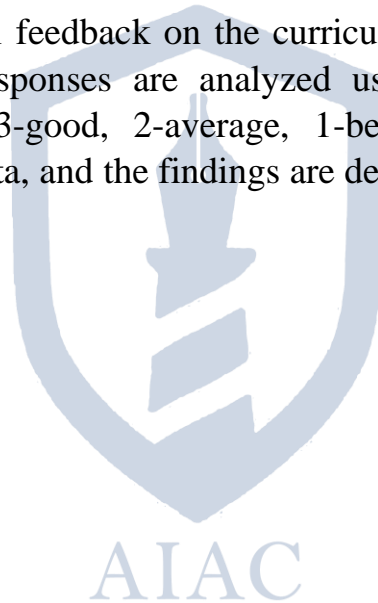

Alumni Feedback Analysis Report 2022-23

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) at Anvarul Islam Arabic College, Kuniyil, collaborates with the college's Alumni Associations to gather feedback on the curriculum through various means. Typically, this feedback is obtained during alumni meets organized by the associations within the college premises. A meticulously designed questionnaire is employed to capture responses, allowing alumni to rate the syllabus and assess its impact on their careers and real-life experiences. The questionnaire aims to evaluate the college's contribution to their overall personality development, the career orientation provided by the syllabus, alignment with societal demands, and the flexibility of the curriculum to adapt to professional requirements.

The survey gathers alumni feedback on the curriculum using a well-structured questionnaire, and the responses are analyzed using a five-point scale (5-excellent, 4-very good, 3-good, 2-average, 1-below average). The model questionnaire, collected data, and the findings are detailed below.

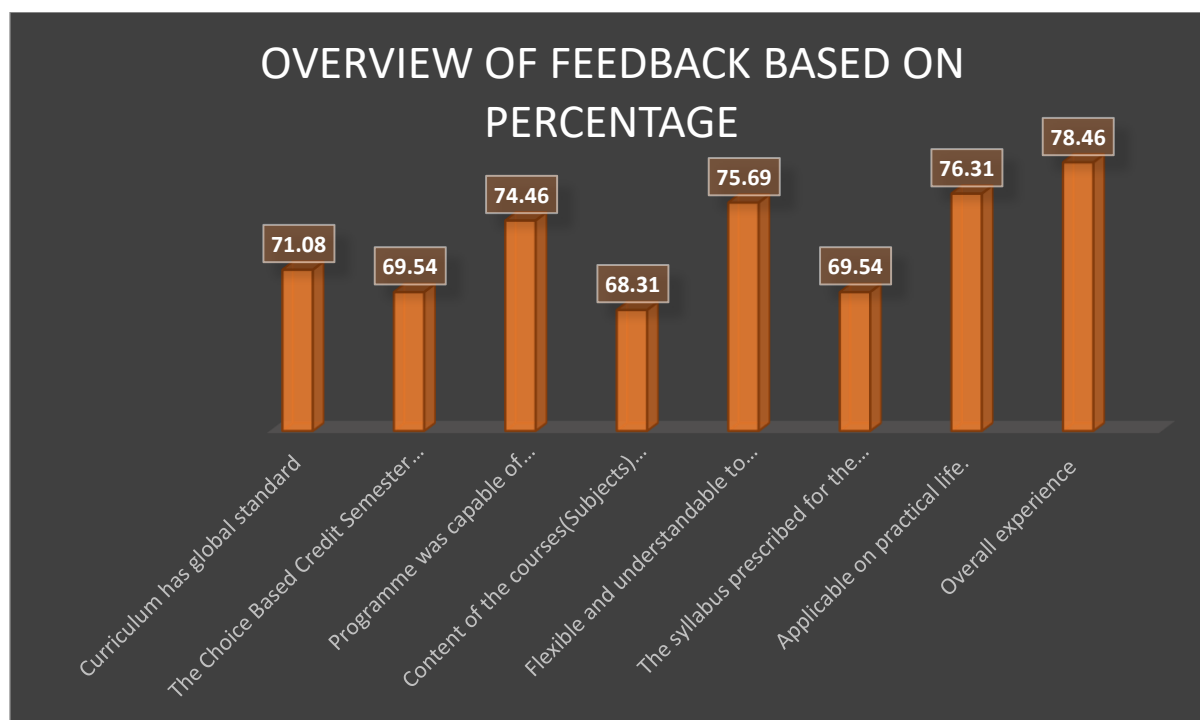

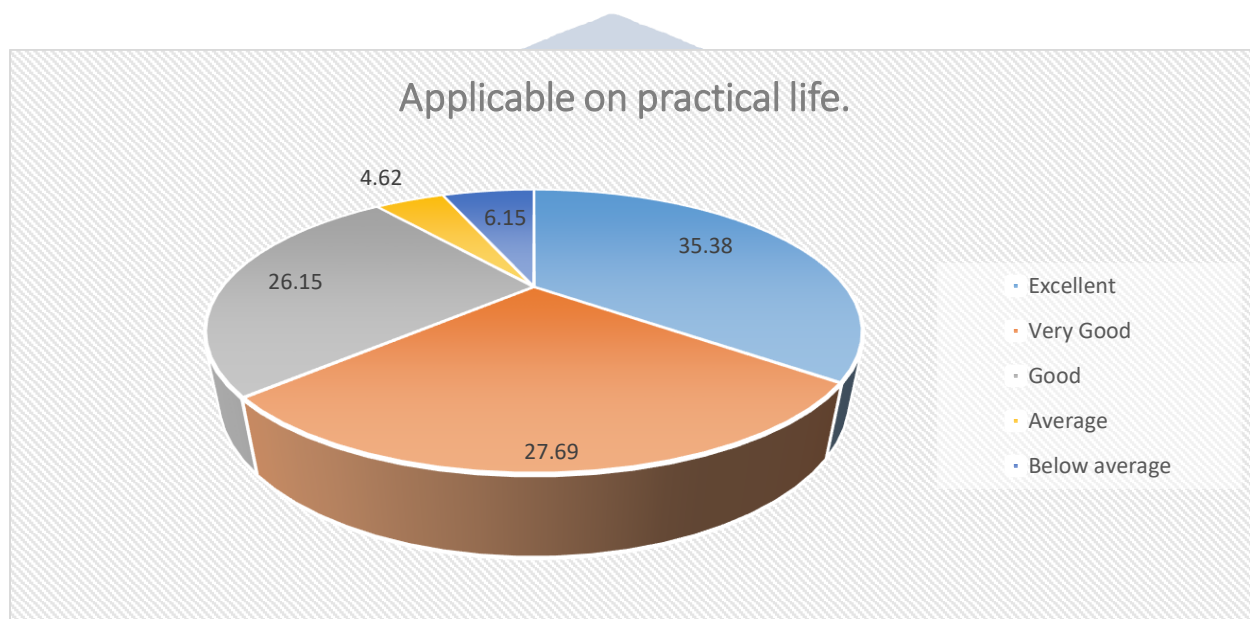
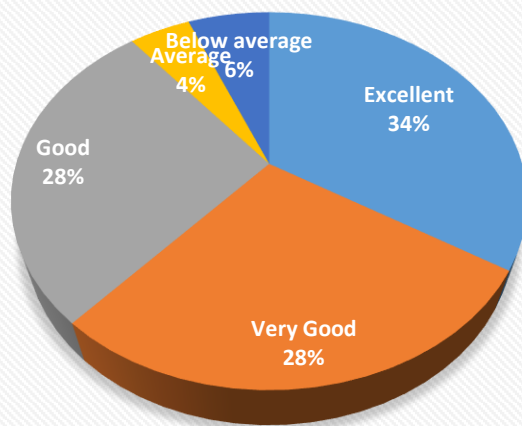

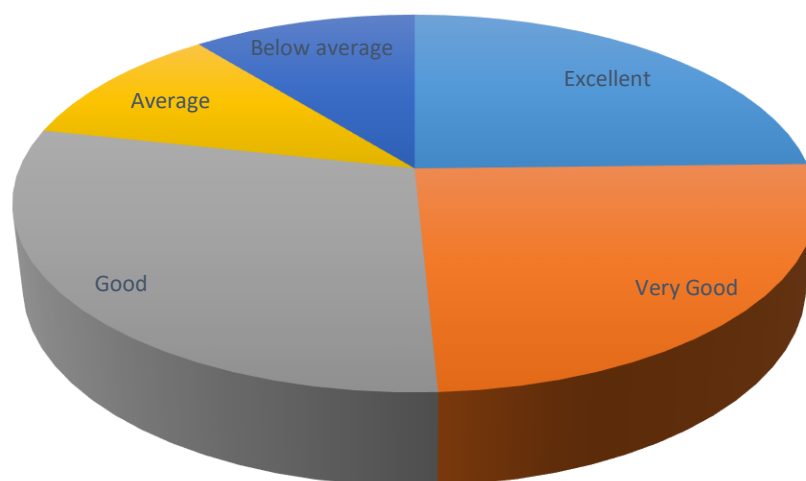

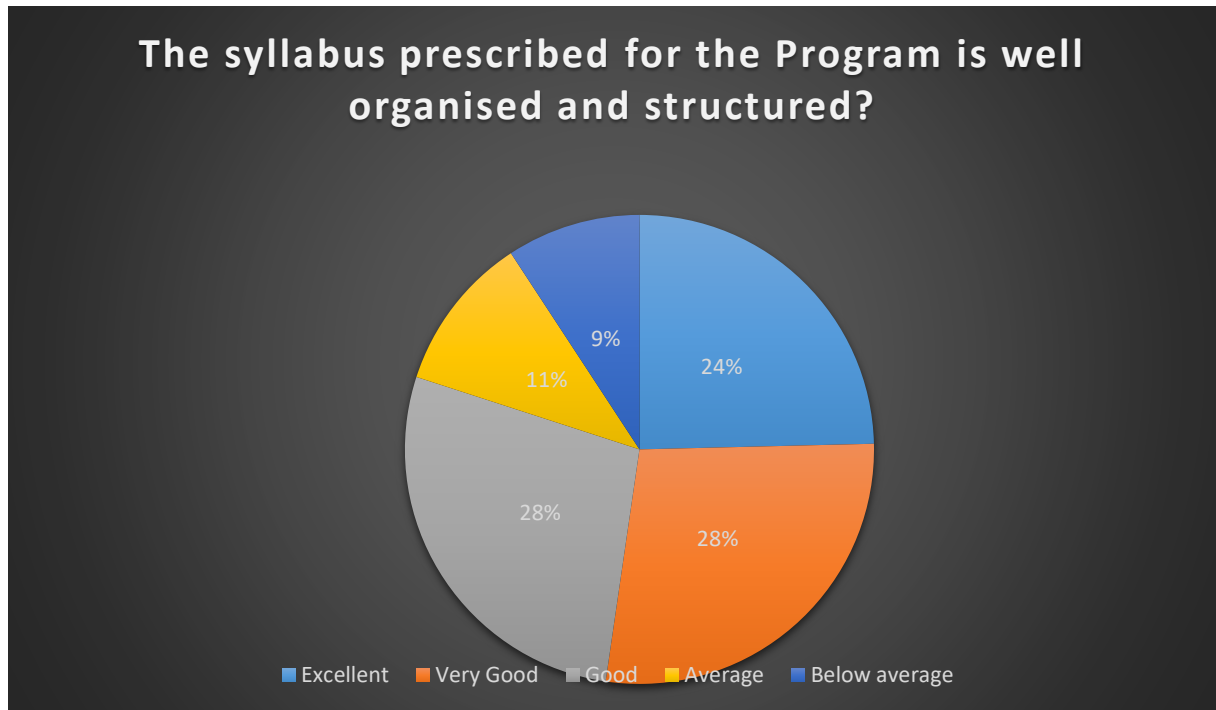
