Students Feedback Analysis Report 2023-24

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) at Anvarul Islam Arabic College, Kuniyil, directly obtains students' feedback on the curriculum. This feedback process is conducted annually, encompassing students from all departments within the college. A meticulously crafted and well-structured questionnaire is employed to elicit responses from the students.

Objectives of the Feedback: The primary aim of the feedback survey is to assess the relevance and significance of the curriculum and its effectiveness in meeting the needs of the academic community. The structured questionnaire addresses various facets of the curriculum that are particularly pertinent to students. It includes inquiries about the enhancement of academic skills through the curriculum, adequacy of classroom infrastructure, evaluation of competency skills, sufficiency of additional skills, awareness of human values, and the content and objectives of curriculum design.

In the survey, students' feedback on the curriculum is gathered using a structured questionnaire and subsequently analyzed using a five-point scale (5-excellent, 4-very good, 3-good, 2-average, 1-below average). The model questionnaire, collected data, and the findings are provided below.



Interpretation:

According to the survey done among the students, it can be observed that the students possess various opinions about the curriculum. The overall opinion about the curriculum is rated as 3.83 in the mean score (76.73), it is observed that a score of 3.73 has been scored for the classroom infrastructure which supports to gain academic knowledge based on the syllabus (74.55%). The mean score for curriculum which is designed to develop a positive attitude and is value based is 3.82(76.49). The institution offers flexibility to choose value added courses 3.90 (77.94), The curriculum has interdisciplinary content 3.89(77.71), The classes are handled by gualified and experienced people 3.87 (77.42). Out of the10 the above 6 points have met the expectations in survey. The mean scores of crosscutting issues regarding to gender, Environment, sustainability, Human Values and Professional Ethics 3.46(69.10), Program is well organized and structured 3.66 (73.12), offer academic related seminars, workshops, conferences and industrial visit 3.69 (73.84%), Relevance of E - resources, library and other facilities 3.69(73.76). These particular points were not reached up to the expectations of IOAC hence IOAC decided to formulate the necessary actions to improve these measures.



Suggestions:

• IQAC and the statutory bodies of the college must collaboratively join to formulate a systematic implementation of the curriculum

in the campus which integrates the professional ethics, gender, environment, human values and sustainability into it.

- The college must provide the students with more E-resources like INFLIBNET and MOOC to make them ease to access. IQAC Blog and Al Durar Lugaviya (YouTube channel) are the two platforms formulated in the college for the enhancement of student's curriculum, which are to be modified.
- IQAC and the departments should jointly host both national and international seminars, industrial visits, field visit etc. to enhance the student's exposure to various disciplines.










Table 11 - The curriculum has interdisciplinary content




Table 12 – Overall learning environment offered in the campus are excellent
